



Policies

Education

- Priority be given to early childhood education and supporting teachers to improve teaching standards
- Establishing a teacher registration board with representation from parents, teachers, unions, universities, business and the ACT government to advise on teaching standards and professional development of teachers
- Investing in more technology for ACT primary and secondary schools

Climate Change

- Establishing a government supported carpooling system to reduce emissions from transport
- Energy efficiency measures- reducing emissions by targeting assistance to boost insulation in existing housing, double glazing and assistance in reducing consumption by large users of power
- Introducing a water wise program which can reduce water consumption by 18%

Public Transport

- Ensuring adequate bus services to cope with the demand
- Developing a bus fleet including 20 passenger electric buses(these are in use in European cities), to meet lower emission targets.
- Reduce traffic congestion through climate change initiatives that reduce cars on the road - such as car pooling'

Planning

- Ensure that development throughout the city is carried out in an orderly manner
- Ensure that Government priorities provide for the upgrading of parking areas in the City and other areas with a review to be undertaken as a matter of urgency
- Revitalizing town and city centres such as Civic, & Dickson and the smaller suburban shopping centres such as Hackett, Watson and Ainslie.

Governance

- More open and transparent government with an emphasize on proper consultation particularly in the future development of Canberra.

Services

- Reversing the downward trend in the provision of services to ACT residents
- Bringing a halt to the privatization and commercialization of large tracts of the territory's public spaces.
- Ensuring that affordable house and land packages are available to first home owners
